## GUESTS:

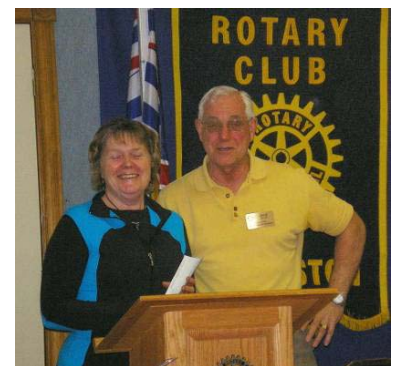
[Margie Hardy](#) - Steveston Community Centre - The Senior's Scene
