OPENING:

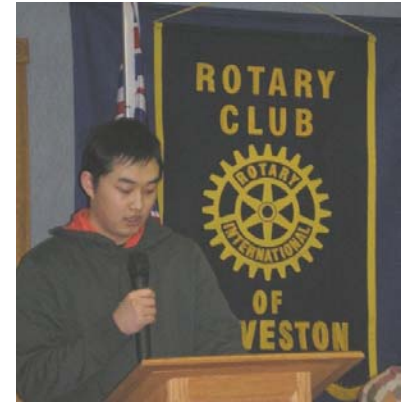
President **Jack Evans** welcomed members and guests to the 7:00 am meeting. **Neville Atkinson** – Toast. **Bob Jones** – invocation.
